**William:** So just to double check Keep walking straight ahead till I pass the library, then I have to turn left and take the first right. Then it's across the bus station. Is that correct? **Kate:** Yes, that is correct.

**William:** Well thanks for helping me. I must go and catch my train, hopefully I haven't missed it!

Kate: OK, bye!
