

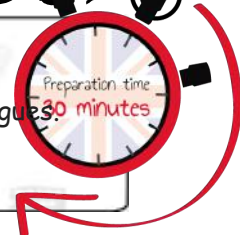
# THE FIRST TIME I SAW YOU

Practice giving your opinion and talking about yourself. Comprehension practice.

**Ross:** That's a difficult question but I would have to say All the Presidents men. And you do you have a favorite movie

**Rachel:** Yes, I like romantic comedies so my favorite movies is 500 days of summer.

**Ross:** Oh that is a great movie, you have good taste.

**Rachel:** Thanks very much, it was nice meeting you.

**Ross:** Likewise, it was a pleasure.



### Dialogue- 2

### Dialogue- 3

**Mary:** Hi it's a pleasure for me to my name is Mary

**Joseph:** It's my first day at the company so I am excited to meet everyone

**Mary:** Well that's good, let me welcome you to our company

**Joseph:** Thanks you are very kind. How long have you been working here?

**Mary:** I have been working here for 5 years. I started back in 2012

**Joseph:** And what is role here?

**Mary:** I work in sales. I started as a customer service assistant and now I manage my own sales team. And you, what is your role?

**Joseph:** I work in IT. I studied computer science in university so I have a strong background in this area.

**Mary:** Oh well that's good to hear. We are always happy to have strong employees in our team.

**Joseph:** That's nice of you. Everyone here seems very nice

**Mary:** Yes, we all get along with each other very well. If you do your job well and are friendly to your colleagues you will enjoy your time here.
